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THREE REQUIREMENTS LIVE-ON FROM VERSIONS B TO C OF AS9100

Even though aviation, space and defense companies are now working to AS9100C, the registrar's auditors have yet to get themselves trained in the updated standard. So they continue to audit against the superseded standard AS9100B. Therefore we still have to take requirements deleted from AS9100B seriously until the registrar's auditors are up to date.

AS9100C no longer specifies three requirements for your management system per the AS9100B clauses shown below:

- 4.2.2 specified that the documented quality manual had to "clearly show" the relationship between AS9100B and the documented procedures in the system.
- 7.4.3 specified that if the organization uses test reports to verify purchased product then the organization shall periodically "validate test reports" for the raw material.
- 8.2.2 specified development (and measure the effectiveness) of "detailed tools and techniques such as check-sheets, process flowcharts, or any similar method" to support audit of the system.

We advise you to keep the parts of your system that conform to these requirements if these requirements add value for your customers, suppliers or your organization.

If not, you should not remove the controls associated with these zombie requirements until your accredited registrar is ready to conduct AS9100C audits.
